The Clean Diaper Change

Following safe protocols for diaper changes is one of the most important ways we can keep ourselves and others healthy.



1 Bring all your changing supplies to the diapering area and cover changing surface with a disposable liner.



2 After changing the diaper, use soap and water to wash the child's hands thoroughly.



3 After the child is in a safe space with adequate supervision, discard soiled diaper and wipes, gloves and disposable liner into the trash can, avoiding touching the lid.



4 Wipe away any visible soil with a damp paper towel or baby wipe, then wet the entire surface with disinfectant, making sure you read the label first to use properly.



5 Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.
